The 3rd annual SHAG adventure race is back for 2008 and this year we have a new venue and added an extra 2 hours for you to enjoy. The race is a USARA National Qualifier and sanctioned Expedition Race with maximum point values up for grabs for teams looking to compete in the USARA national rankings. Teams of 2,3,4 and solo competitors will tackle the woods, wilds and waters of the lower Hudson Valley region along the border of Northern NJ and Southern NY. The exact venue and locations will be kept secret until a few weeks before the race. This year's race will explore some new terrain and parks as well as venture into some of the better known gems (although rarely traveled areas) of the Hudson Valley region. The course will reward and delight racers of all ability levels from first timers to experienced teams with fantastic terrain and spectacular views. Course design will feature a modified rogaine format which will allow teams to collect optional CPs at their discretion. The team with the most points at the end of the 26 hour race will be crowned SHAG champions.

- Rogaine Style Course (equally challenging to beginners and top navigators)

- Single Track Mountain Biking
- Some of the best scenic terrain & views in the area
- Includes new parks and terrain, unused in other races
